Background	The Manual of Air Traffic Services (MATS) version 71 and the Aeronautical Information Publication (AIP Book) AL 122 will become effective on 20 March 2025.

These changes are described in the change summary in the published document but are not included in the AIRAC briefing document.

NAPM to MATS Procedural approach separation responsibilities	Inserts existing NAPM clause into Transfer of separation responsibility section. Section affected: 10.1.5	38145
Jetstar Speed Table Updates	Updates speed data guidance table for the current Jetstar fleet. Section affected: 9.5.1	39797
NAPM to MATS new information register responsibility	Incorporate NAPM 2.5.1.1 into MATS 2.6.1.1.1 Section affected: 2.6.1	37996
NAPM to MATS Class D Simultaneous Parallel Operations	Incorporate the NAPM provisions for simultaneous parallel runway/landing area operations at Class D aerodromes. Section(s) affected: 1.1.1 and 10.9.8	38000

AIP Changes

Where possible, references to noteworthy amendments have been included (references may not indicate all amendments relating to that topic). Minor editorial and format changes are not shown in this summary.

Two letter designators. Operators with two letter designators to use a numerical suffix of at least two numbers. *GEN 3.4 para 5.15.3*

Phraseology. Take-off when not in association with a runway clearance or instruction. *GEN 3.4 para 6.16.3*.

Alternate Aerodromes. Changes align the AIP with intended current practice of *Chapter 7 of the Part 91 Manual of Standards. ENR 1.1 Section 10.7.*

Circling approaches and visual circling. More closely aligned with *PANS-OPS Volume II and CASR Part 173. ENR 1.5 Section 1.6.*

Air Traffic Incidents. Updates to definitions and examples of reportable serious aircraft incident - *ENR 1.14 para 4.5, 4.6 and 4.7*.

Implementation of Conditional Routes (CDR). Information following successful trial. *ENR 3.5* Section 2, ENR 5.1 para 2.3.

Civil use of military air bases. Reflects the legal direction from CASA. *AD 1.1 Section 2*.
