# **GOLD COAST (YBCG) AIRPORT PACIFIC AIRSHOW 2024 APRON IMPACTS AND GA PARKING RESTRICTIONS**

## **1. INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 This AIC intends to provide information and notification on the role of Gold Coast Airport (GCA) during the Pacific Airshow 2024 (PA24), to be held on the Gold Coast Friday 16 August to Sunday 18 August 2024.
- 1.2 Elements affecting aerodrome/apron operations at Gold Coast Airport are scheduled between Wednesday 14 August and Monday 19 August.
- 1.3 GCA will be hosting a number of performance aircraft for the event though there is no public access component.
- 1.4 The Airshow performance area is not in the immediate vicinity of the aerodrome.
- 1.5 Sitting of the "Performance Apron Special Event Zone (SEZ)" is detailed at Appendix 1.

## 2. APRON IMPACTS

- 2.1 The following section provides details of the aerodrome facilities affected by the PA24 activities.
- 2.2 The following apron and taxiway facilities will be unavailable for regular air traffic operations between Wednesday 14 August and Monday 19 August.
  - RPT apron Bay 1 MARS and Bay 2
  - Remote stand MARS 30
  - Taxiway Alpha from Bay 2 eastwards
  - Associated GSE storage and apron access roads
  - Facilities may be subject to change at short notice.
- 2.3 RPT A temporary “Performance Apron” will be delineated by US cones and yellow taxiway markers within the confines of the affected area.

## 3. FLIGHT OPERATIONS IMPACTS

- 3.1 Specific impacts to air operations and procedures will be detailed in a separate AIP SUP to be raised by technical stakeholders in liaison with regulators and the event organiser.

## 4. GA AIRCRAFT PARKING IMPACTS AND CONSIDERATIONS

- 4.1 General Aviation parking space at Gold Coast Airport is limited.
- 4.2 As the GA parking apron at Gold Coast Airport is generally at capacity and occupied by local operators the airport is unable to accept bookings or reservations for itinerant recreational aircraft over the show period (Monday 12 - Monday 19 August).
- 4.3 Parking for other purposes will only be permitted with express permission of Gold Coast Airport.
- 4.4 GCA recommends show attendees travelling to the Gold Coast avoid use of private/chartered aircraft and consider alternative methods of travel to avoid disappointment and to minimise logistical and safety concerns.

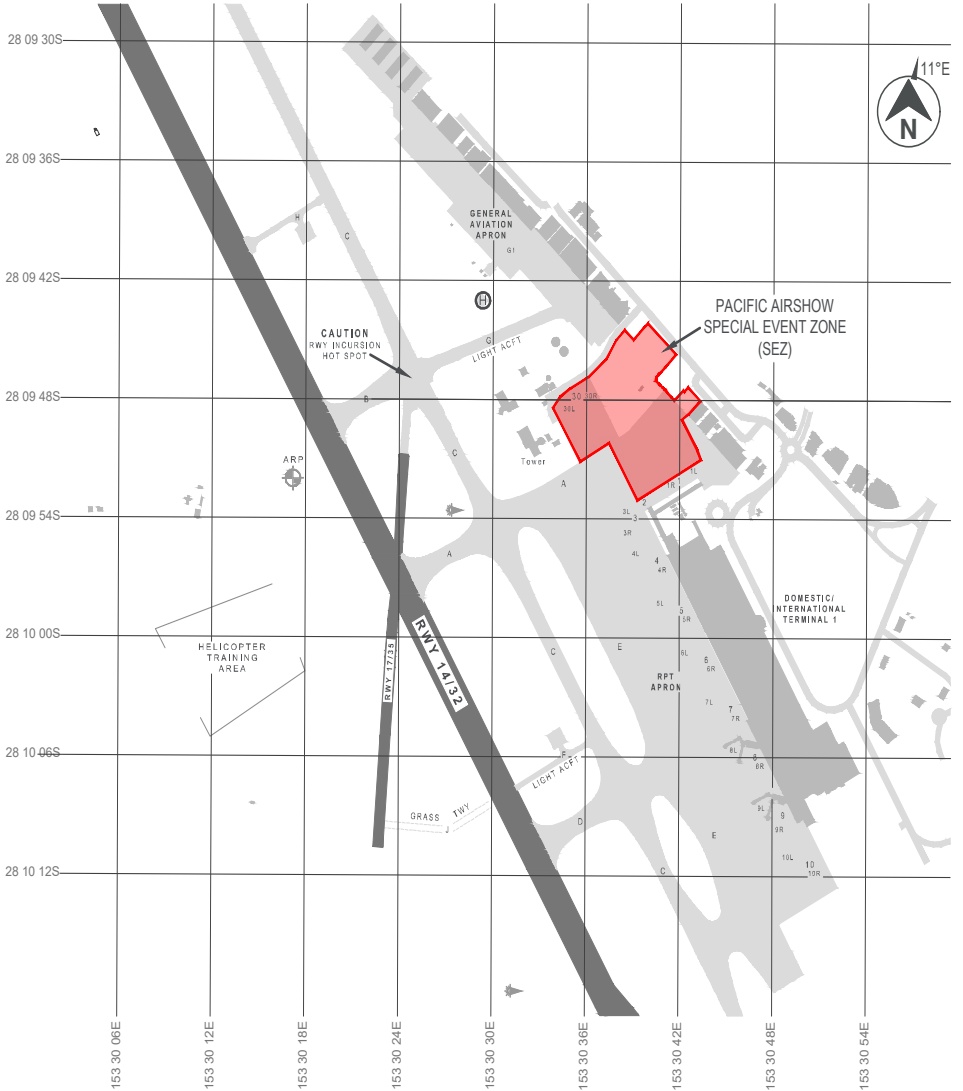
