PERTH AERODROME (YPPH) ELEVATED STOP BARS

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 This AIC is to provide forward notification of installation of the elevated stop bars at runway holding positions on TWY A7, A9, A11, J1, V (north side) and TWY N to supplement the existing inset stop bar lighting. The elevated stop bars will be gradually installed between 29 November and mid December 2024.
- 1.2 Elevated stop bars will progressively be added to all holding positions at Perth Aerodrome.

2. OPERATIONAL INFORMATION

- 2.1 Stop bars are required at all holding positions to minimise delays in RVR conditions less than 550M. Perth Aerodrome operate stop bars H24.
- 2.2 Stop bars consist of unidirectional lights spaced at 3M intervals across the taxiway, showing red in the direction of approach to the holding position.
- 2.3 Stop bars are considered a valuable defence against aircraft and vehicles inadvertently entering a runway without Air Traffic Control (ATC) clearance.
- 2.4 An aircraft taxiing or a vehicle operating on the maneuvering area must stop and hold at all lighted stop bars. The aircraft or vehicle may only proceed further when in receipt of a clearance by ATC and the stop bar lights have been switched off.
- 2.5 The red stop bar light is switched off as the verbal instruction is given to reinforce that an aircraft or vehicle is cleared to enter the runway.

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- 2.6 If the stop bar lights have not been switched off after receipt of a clearance, the pilot or vehicle driver MUST seek clarification from ATC. **Do not** cross an illuminated stop bar.
- 2.7 Where a stop bar fails and cannot be turned off, ATC will implement stop bar contingency procedures as per AIP ENR 1.1.






